HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:

Hill College operates five vocational nursing education programs which utilize the same curriculum, policies and central administration. The vocational nursing education programs are located at Hillsboro, Cleburne, Glen Rose and Clifton (day and evening with two codes). The administration is notifying the Board regarding consolidation of the five vocational nursing programs into one program utilizing the current program code for the program located at Hillsboro.

At the July 19-20, 2007 meeting, the members of the Board of Nurse Examiners reviewed the notification from Hill College regarding consolidation of the Vocational Nursing (VN) Education Programs at Hillsboro, Cleburne, Glen Rose and Clifton (day and evening with two codes). The Hill College Vocational Nursing Education Programs at Hillsboro, Cleburne, Glen Rose and Clifton (day and evening with two codes) will be considered as one program effective August 1, 2007 with the main campus located at Hillsboro and the four other programs considered as extension campuses.

The program code that will be utilized for the consolidated program is 27-121. Students who graduate from the consolidated vocational nursing education program after August 1, 2007 shall use this program code. The Program Codes, 27-279, 27-209, 27-292, and 27-102 will be deactivated.
