

**ELIGIBILITY AND DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE REPORT FOR**  
**November 13, 2007**

This report is written to describe E&D Committee actions and trends. There were three (3) Eligibility Requests, five (5) Eligibility Agreed Orders, three (3) Reinstatement Agreed Orders, forty-four (44) Disciplinary Agreed Orders, twenty-two (22) Default Revocation Orders, and three (3) Motions for Rehearing.

**NATURE OF ELIGIBILITY REQUESTS AND RESOLUTIONS**

**PETITIONER / APPLICANTS: (3)**

**Approved with Stipulations (3):**

1. Female Petitioner charged October 7, 1998, w/misdemeanor Shoplifting, entered plea of guilty and was sentenced to thirty (30) days confinement or pay a fine of \$425. Charged June 15, 2000 w/misdemeanor Resisting Arrest, entered plea of nolo contendere and was assessed a fine of \$200. December 3, 2003, Petitioner was charged with state jail felony offense of Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle, entered a plea of guilty and was deferred w/o adjudication of guilt/placed on three (3) years probation. Probation completed December 3, 2006.
2. Female Petitioner charged October 3, 1995, w/ state jail offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance - Cocaine, entered a plea of guilty and proceedings were deferred w/o adjudication of guilt. Petitioner was placed on three (3) years community supervision and was discharged from community supervision on December 3, 1998. August 1, 2003, Petitioner was convicted of misdemeanor offense of Failure to Identify, entered plea of guilty and was sentenced to fifteen (15) days confinement.
3. Female Petitioner engaged in delinquent conduct, Aggravated Robbery and Theft from person on January 27, 1994, and attempted murder on July 22, 1994. Petitioner was committed August 26, 1994, to the custody of the Texas Youth Commission until she was 21 years of age. Charge of Class A misdemeanor offense of Assault Causing Bodily Injury on September 25, 1998, w/ disposition of conviction on January 20, 1999, and sentenced to three (3) days confinement, a fine and court costs of \$224.

There were three (3) Eligibility Requests, seven (7) Eligibility Agreed Orders, four (4) Reinstatement Agreed Orders, twenty-eight (28) Disciplinary Agreed Orders, eighteen (18) Default Revocation Orders, two (2) ALJ Proposal for Decisions, and six (6) Petitioners' Requests for Exception to a Previous Board Order.

**NATURE OF ELIGIBILITY REQUESTS AND RESOLUTIONS**

**PETITIONER / APPLICANTS: (3)**

**Approved with Stipulations (3):**

1. Male Petitioner charged March 29, 1993, w/third degree felony Theft of a Vehicle, entered a plea of guilty and proceedings were deferred w/o adjudication of guilt, placed on four (4) years probation. Petitioner released from probation January 23, 1996. Charged September 2, 1993, w/misdemeanor offense of Driving While License Suspended, entered a plea of guilty and was sentenced to three (3) days confinement in jail and assessed a fine of \$200. Charged December 21, 2005, w/ misdemeanor offense of Driving while Intoxicated, entered a plea of guilty and was placed on community supervision for twenty (20) months. Probation expired September 24, 2007.
2. Female Petitioner charged June 20, 2003, w/the state jail felony offense of Welfare Fraud, entered a plea of guilty and proceedings were deferred w/o adjudication of guilt. Petitioner was placed on three (3) years community supervision. Discharged from community supervision February 25, 2006.
3. Female Petitioner charged September 24, 1998, w/the third degree felony offense of Intoxication Assault. A court verdict of guilty was entered. Petitioner was sentenced to seven (7) years imprisonment, which was probated to seven (7) years supervision. On September 25, 2005, Petitioner was discharged from probation. One June 1, 1998, Petitioner was charged w/the Class A misdemeanor offense of Theft of Property, entered a plea of guilty and proceedings were deferred w/o adjudication of guilt, placed on one (1) year probation and was discharged from probation June 10, 1999.
