

ELIGIBILITY AND DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE REPORT FOR
May 13, 2008

This report is written to describe E&D Committee actions and trends. There were five (5) Eligibility Requests, two (2) Petitioners for Exception to a Previous Board Order, twelve (12) Eligibility Agreed Orders, four (4) Reinstatement Agreed Orders, thirty-three (33) Disciplinary Agreed Orders, thirty (30) Default Revocation Orders, and two (2) Motions for Rehearing.

NATURE OF ELIGIBILITY REQUESTS AND RESOLUTIONS

PETITIONER / APPLICANTS: (5)

Approved with Stipulations (4):

1. Male Petitioner charged March 30, 2006, w/3rd degree felony offense of False Statement of Vehicle Registration Act and state jail felony offense of Unlawfully Filing an Insurance Claim by Fraud, entered pleas of guilty and were deferred without adjudication of guilt. Petitioner was placed on five (5) years probation, discharged early from probation on Feb. 8, 2008.
2. Female Petitioner convicted on Nov. 20, 1992, of felony offense of Robbery and sentenced to six (6) years probation, completed probation on Dec. 1, 1999. Petitioner was charged Feb. 16, 1998, w/misdemeanor offense of Theft of Property, entered a plea of guilty and was sentenced to one (1) year probation, probation revoked Jan. 7, 2002. Charged Jan. 12, 2002, w/misdemeanor offense of Theft by Check w/charges dismissed after restitution was paid in full.
3. Male Applicant charged on March 10, 2001, w/offenses of Larceny, Forgery, and Mail Fraud by the US Air Force, entered plea of guilty, received one (1) year of extra duty and was assessed a fine of \$3,658. Applicant was charged on Dec. 8, 2005, w/offense of Attempted Unauthorized Use of a Credit Card, was granted an Order of Conditional Discharge for 24 months, completed conditions of the conditional discharge on Dec. 6, 2007. Charged April 11, 2007, with misdemeanor offense of Domestic Battery, entered a plea of guilty and proceedings were deferred without adjudication of guilt and was placed on six (6) months probation. Applicant seen by Forensic Psychological Evaluator and Polygrapher on Feb. 27, 2006. Evaluator concludes that she cannot presently provide any opinions with regard to Applicant's ability to be in accordance with Board Rules.
4. Female Applicant issued Voluntary Surrender of License in Lieu of other Disciplinary Action Order on May 19, 2005, by the Nevada State Board of Nursing, issued agreement for five (5) years probation by the NV Board of Nursing on September 13, 2007, Applicant current with all terms of probation as of April 2, 2008. Applicant's Licensure by

Endorsement Application was considered by the Exec. Director of BON, and Applicant was found ineligible for licensure. Applicant submitted letter dated April 12, 2008, by sponsor since June 2006. Applicant has been diligent in completing all 12 steps.

Continued (1):

1. Male Applicant charged on Nov. 1, 1999, with offenses of Unlawfully Carrying a Weapon and Possession of Marijuana, sentenced to nine (9) months probation. Charged June 19, 1999, w/felony offense of Manufacturing/Distribution of a Schedule I Drug, entered plea of guilty and was sentenced to 300 days confinement, probated to three (3) years probation. Applicant convicted Oct. 20, 1999, of state jail felony offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance-Cocaine, was sentenced to two (2) years probation, probation completed June 29, 2003.

ELIGIBILITY AGREED ORDERS (12): Approved.

**ELIGIBILITY AND DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE REPORT FOR
June 10, 2008**

This report is written to describe E&D Committee actions and trends. There were three (3) Eligibility Requests, three (3) Petitioners for Exception to a Previous Board Order, one (1) Motion for Rehearing, twelve (12) Eligibility Agreed Orders, one (1) Reinstatement Agreed Orders, thirty-one (31) Disciplinary Agreed Orders, and seventeen (17) Default Revocation Orders.

NATURE OF ELIGIBILITY REQUESTS AND RESOLUTIONS

PETITIONER / APPLICANTS: (3)

Approved with Stipulations (3):

1. Female Petitioner charged June 17, 2004, w/state jail felony offense of Criminal Mischief, entered a plea of guilty, proceedings were deferred without adjudication and was placed on three (3) years of probation, completed probation June 20, 2007. Charged August 20, 2004, w/the misdemeanor offense of Assault Causing Bodily Injury, entered a plea of guilty, proceedings were deferred without adjudication of guilt, and Petitioner was placed on twelve (12) months probation, probation completed Aug. 22, 2005.
2. Female Applicant charged on or about Aug. 22, 2003, with 2nd degree felony offense of Possession of a Controlled Substance, entered plea of guilty and was sentenced to four (4) years probation, probation completed Aug. 24, 2007. Applicant was arrested for felony offense of Manslaughter, appeared before the Grand Jury and was presented with a "No True Bill" verdict. Applicant seen by Forensic Psychological Evaluation on March 14, 2008. Results showed Applicant to not meet criteria for any psychological diagnosis, including or related to chemical abuse or dependency. Polygraph exam supports that Applicant has not used illegal drugs since 2001 and has never abused prescription medications. It is evaluator's opinion that it is probable that Applicant will be able to consistently behave in accordance with the requirements of the Board's Rules.
3. Female Applicant charged May 4, 2001, w/misdemeanor offense of Assault Causing Bodily Injury, entered a plea of guilty and was sentenced to fifteen (15) months probation, completed probation on September 9, 2002.
