

**Summary Report of Survey Visits Conducted by Contract Program Evaluators and Board Staff
June, 2012 – August, 2013**

Summary:

This report presents the positive effects upon the total number of nursing program survey visits completed during a fifteen (15) month period when contract program evaluators were employed to assist Board Staff in providing overdue program visits. The first table lists survey visits conducted by five (5) contract program evaluators during the time period. An additional table lists survey visits conducted by Nursing Consultants for Education. The total number of programs visited was eighty-six (86).

Background:

- Rules 214.4(c)(4) and 215.4(c)(4) state that nursing education programs shall be visited at least every six (6) years unless accredited by a Board-recognized national nursing accrediting agency.
- There are ninety-nine (99) vocational nursing programs and one hundred thirteen (113) professional nursing programs in Texas. A total of ninety (90) approved nursing education programs hold national nursing accreditation, leaving a total of one hundred twenty-three (123) approved programs to be visited by Board staff at least every six (6) years. This does not include survey visits needed to new program sites and to programs with sanctions or problems.
- Because of the influx of proposals for new programs during the past eight (8) years as well as the increasing number of programs with sanctions, Board Staff have devoted more time to new programs or to programs experiencing problems. By 2012, the backlog of programs needing a regular six-year survey visit was approximately sixty (60) vocational programs and twelve (12) professional programs. (Some of these visits related to approval changes.)
- During June and July 2012, the practice of contracting survey visits was piloted and found to be successful.
- Five (5) qualified program evaluators from various regions in the state were chosen through the RFP contract process and began providing services in August 2012. By the time the contracts had ended on August 31, 2013, they had conducted seventy (70) survey visits, constituting a "survey blitz" across the state as well as a giant step toward meeting the requirement for all approved programs to receive a survey visit (See Table #1). In addition, Board Staff also conducted sixteen (16) survey visits during this time period (See Table #2).

Evaluation of the Use of Contract Program Evaluators:

- Board Staff sent an online survey to all programs visited by the contract program evaluators in September 2013. Thirty-three (33) programs responded to the five (5) question survey.
- Results from the survey are provided in the following table:

Anecdotal comments from program directors:

- “This was an awesome experience. The Program Evaluator was kind and helpful while helping us find ways to improve our program. She also put me in contact with some helpful resources.”
- “The visit was conducted very professionally as well as very personable.”
- “The visit was a great experience for us; the Program Evaluator was very thorough. She requested information prior to the visit so we were prepared. She visited the clinical sites and spent time with the students. The exit interview with the administration was excellent since most of them had never experienced a survey visit. The recommendations that were made will enhance our program and make it more successful.”
- “The survey visit itself was helpful and provided the program with great feedback; however, the report of the survey visit has not been received yet.”
- “The Program Evaluator made suggestions that helped us improve. When will our next visit be?”
- “The Program Evaluator represented the Texas BON professionally and she made the survey a learning experience for the whole faculty and staff.”
- “The Program Evaluator put my faculty and myself at ease. I am very glad she came for our site visit.”
- “I am very appreciative of the interest our Program Evaluator took in preparing to visit our program. She was extremely down-to-earth and was very helpful in explaining the specific things she was looking at.”
- “The Program Evaluator was very helpful and straightforward. She offered several needed suggestions and answered all my questions honestly. She is very professional but approachable which I fully appreciate.”

Several programs would like to have received written feedback on the visit earlier. Board Staff had to wait until the report was submitted by the Program Evaluator, review the report, and dialogue with the Evaluator before providing the draft report to the program. This delayed some programs from receiving the reports earlier.

Following many of the survey visits, Board Staff also received many positive comments from program directors about the experience.

Conclusion:

Employing contract program evaluators, providing orientation and guidance to them, and consulting with them has been a very effective way to manage the workload involved in regular program evaluation and may be considered in the future. Board Staff have been able to reconnect to many programs in the state who are doing well, but have not had a survey for many years.
