

Proposed Rule Review of Chapter 227 (Pilot Programs for Innovative Applications to Professional Nursing Education)

Section 2001.039 of the Texas Government Code requires each agency to review each of its rules every four (4) years and consider whether to re-adopt, re-adopt with amendments, or repeal each rule. The proposed rule review of Chapter 227 (Pilot Programs for Innovative Applications to Professional Nursing Education) will be posted in the *Texas Register* following the Board meeting pursuant to this statutory requirement. This rule is continuously assessed to determine whether the reasons for originally adopting the chapter continue to exist. Each section of this chapter is continually re-evaluated to determine whether it is obsolete, reflects current legal and policy considerations, reflects current procedures and practices of the Board, and/or whether it is in compliance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code (The Administrative Procedure Act). The public has thirty (30) days to comment on the rule review and to submit any response or suggestions. No action is required by the Board.

This rule review completes the implementation of the Board's rule review plan for 2007 - 2011 that is available on the Secretary of State's website.
